

MAGARI

(mah-GAH-ree)



Magari is an often-used Italian expression with different meanings: “If only it was true...!”, “I wish...!”. It carries a hint of irony which leads people to smile.

Appellation Bolgheri D.O.P.

Grape varieties Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot.

Vineyards

Located in Bolgheri both on dark soils rich in clay and loam and on white soils full of limestone, clay and stones.

Winemaking method

The three varieties ferment and macerate separately. After 16-18 months of ageing in oak, they are blended and then aged for a few months in the bottle before release.

Characteristics

The bouquet recalls red fruits and aromatic herbs typical of the Mediterranean scrub found in the area. Full and smooth mouthfeel with a pleasant freshness and sapidity.

First vintage produced 2000
