The name is reminiscent of the Italian word “promessa”, which means promise. It is a nod to our family’s commitment to creating a valuable project in Tuscany. The wine has a young and bold character with a fresh breeze of liveliness.

Appellation Toscana I.G.P.

Grape varieties Merlot, Syrah, Sangiovese.

Vineyards

Mainly from Bibbona, planted on dark soils rich in clay and loam.

Winemaking method

The three varieties ferment and macerate separately. After 12 months of ageing in oak, they are blended and then aged for a few months in the bottle before release.

Characteristics

The roundness of Merlot and the spiciness of Syrah match with the essential rigor and freshness of Sangiovese. Harmonious and enjoyable from the very beginning.
