

# VISTAMARE

(VEES-tah-MAH-reh)



*Vistamare (sea view) recalls the cheerfulness of sunny days on the Italian coast. The name was ironically borrowed from the real estate world where a sea view is the ultimate luxurious detail.*

**Appellation** Toscana I.G.P.

**Grape varieties** Vermentino, Viognier, Fiano.

## **Vineyards**

The first vineyard of Vistamare was planted in 2005 in the municipality of Bibbona, on a hillside overlooking the Tyrrhenian coast. The subsequent vineyards were planted few years after in Bolgheri, closer to the winery.

## **Winemaking method**

Fermentation in stainless steel and ageing in stainless steel and oak for 6 months.

## **Characteristics**

The fresh and herbaceous notes of Vermentino combine with the complexity and roundness of Viognier. Fiano adds a floral and botanical note to the bouquet. The nose is generous with peach, apricot, sage, and marine notes, revealing a fresh, rounded, and lingering taste.
