

ROSSJ-BASS

(ROH-see BAHS)



A blend of grapes from different vineyards, including Rossj, which Lucia and Angelo named after their second daughter, Rossana.

Appellation Langhe D.O.P.

Grape varieties Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc.

Vineyards

The first vineyard of Rossj-Bass was planted in 1984 in the center of Barbaresco village. The other vineyards are in the Barbaresco area (*Cars, Pozzo, and Pajorè*) in Serralunga d'Alba (*Vivaldo 1-2 and Feja*) and Trezzo (*Serra Pini, Boscasso, and Cascina Langa*).

Winemaking method

Stainless steel fermentation and ageing in stainless steel and oak for 6 months.

Characteristics

Aromas of white flowers and citrus with a hint of honey; pronounced acidity and a fresh, lingering finish.

First vintage produced 1988
